## What We Do

- Distribute food with a low-waste model
- Receive and purchase food from our community partners
- Sell produce at a fraction of grocery store cost
- Pack boxes of groceries for families in need of pantry items
- Prepare donated food into hot meals to be picked up by local residents and served during our Community Meals

## Who do we help?

### Meals

- Our hot meal program benefits low-income, elderly and disabled clients who have difficulty procuring fresh, low cost food for themselves
- Our Community Meals gather folks in for lunch 4 days/week (Tues, Wed, Fri, and Sat 12:30-2:30)

### Pantry

- Our pantry program assists families experiencing food insecurity

### Store

- Our store at 3702 Washington St. is *open to all* on a walk-in basis!
- We sell produce, bread, pantry staples, and even sweets at a fraction of grocery store prices.

We do not require recipients to prove their income, residency, employment status, or age to receive food.
